



Girls at Work Classes



Girls at Work, Inc. is a nonprofit organization dedicated to teaching the craft of woodworking to girls and women in a safe and supportive environment. We provide many different opportunities for learning. Please select your preferred method of learning from the following options.

Team Building

This creates an opportunity for camp staff to realize the synergies that exist between them as they work as a team to build a common project that is used for the camp. Girls at Work will travel to the camp to build either picnic tables or benches. The project will be agreed upon by the camp and Girls at Work, Inc. ahead of time. This is offered to both male and female staff.

Materials Expense: The camp is responsible for providing and purchasing all materials ahead of time for the project. A material list will be provided to you upon registration.

- Time Commitment: Full day (including travel time if under one hour)
- Number of Staff: GAW can work with a maximum of 40 staff members. Minimum 3 staff per bench and up to 6 staff per picnic table.

Cost: \$900.00-1200.00*

Staff Training

This creates an opportunity for camp staff to learn the basic skills and equipment needed to start their own woodworking program. Selected staff will travel to the Girls at Work, Inc. workshop in Goffstown, NH to learn how to teach woodworking along with dealing with common challenges they may encounter in shop.

- Time Commitment: Three days
- Lodging for camp staff: Staff is welcome to bring tents and camp onsite. A porta potty will be onsite for convenience.
- Meals for camp staff: Girls at Work will provide all meals.
- No woodworking experience is needed

Cost: \$350.00 per staff member

On the Road**

Girls at Work, Inc. will travel to your camp and teach your girls how to build a shaker peg board during a one hour class, using several different power tools. We offer this to ten girls an hour with up to eight classes per day. This is a great opportunity to be able to offer woodworking to girls without having to staff your own woodworking program. We will bring all the materials and equipment needed for the project.

- Materials Expense: Included in fee
- Time Commitment: Dependent upon number of girls
- Number of girls: Minimum of 60 girls required or a maximum of 80 girls per day
- Space Needed: GAW will need a covered space with tables and a power source.

Cost: \$15.00 per girl* for shaker peg board

*There will be an additional fee for travel over an hour.
